Transmits and receives handwritten messages over regular telephone lines or private lines—across town or across the nation

- Provides direct communications between telewriting business machines—
  - transmits and receives handwritten information
- Transmits and receives at the speed of freehand writing—what is written at the sending station is instantly recorded at the receiving station.
- Provides DATA-PHONE Service on regular telephone lines for local or long distance handwritten communications at normal telephone rates—
  - provides two-way voice communications with called station

- switches to one-way or two-way handwritten communications at the touch of a button
- requires no special training to operate
- Operates in the same manner on Private Line service or WATS service at a fixed monthly charge.
- Offers unattended automatic answering controls—
  - automatic tone signal alerts calling station that your machine is connected and is ready to receive the handwritten message
  - calling station can automatically disconnect distant machine at end of transmission
